RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION COVERING THE ABANDONMENT OF AN UNOPENED 50-FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED SOUTHWEST OF THE INTERSECTION OF STONINGTON DRIVE AND GOLD CREST DRIVE

WHEREAS, James Lee McGuffee petitioned the Chattanooga-Hamilton County Regional Planning Commission for the abandonment of an unopened 50-foot right-of-way located southwest of the intersection of Stonington Drive and Gold Crest Drive, and said Planning Commission after hearing recommended that this petition be denied; and

WHEREAS, James Lee McGuffee requested that the County Commission consider said petition and notice has been published in a newspaper in general circulation in Hamilton County that the County Commission will hold a public hearing on September 18, 2002, concerning the passage of this Resolution as required by law, and such having been held.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THIS COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED: That the zoning regulations of Hamilton County be amended to cover the abandonment of an unopened 50-foot right-of-way located southwest of the intersection of Stonington Drive and Gold Crest Drive. An unopened fifty foot wide right-of-way extending southwest 74.9 feet from the cul-de-sac of Stonington Drive. Said right-of-way separates Lot 25, Corrective Plat Lot 25 Gold Point Estates, Plat Book 57, Page 144, ROHC, from Lot 26 Corrective Plat of Gold Point Estates, Plat Book 38, Page 18, ROHC. Tax Map 101B-D-001 and 092P-B-013 as shown on the attached map.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT THIS RESOLUTION TAKE EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE, THE PUBLIC WELFARE REQUIRING IT.
