

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Chattanooga petitioned the Chattanooga-Hamilton County Regional Planning Commission to recommend to the Members of the City Council of the City of Chattanooga the abandonment of an unopened, 15 foot wide alley beginning on the southeast line of the 2600 block of Lockwood Avenue, thence extending 135 feet southwest to a dead-end.

Said alley separates lots 1 thru 3 from lot 13, map of Mills Subdivision Glass Farm, Plat Book 7, Page 6, R.O.H.C. Tax Map 137A-H-003 thru 007 as shown on the attached map.

AND WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on this petition on December 9, 2002,

AND WHEREAS, the Planning Commission heard and considered all statements favoring the petition,

AND WHEREAS, no one was present in opposition to the petition,

AND WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has studied the existing pattern of development.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Planning Commission, on December 9, 2002, recommended to the Members of the City Council of the City of Chattanooga that this petition be approved, subject to the approval of the City Engineer and all public utilities.



