

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Chattanooga petitioned the Chattanooga-Hamilton County Regional Planning Commission to recommend to the Members of the City Council of the City of Chattanooga the abandonment of a portion of the 2000 block of Cushman Street.

Abandonment of a portion of the 2000 block of Cushman Street beginning at its intersection with the 2900 block of Curtis Street and extending some 140 feet northwest. Said right-of-way separates Lot 9, Block 2, Andersons Addition, Plat Book 3, Page 4, ROHC from Lot 1, Final Plat of Lots 1 and 2, Amnicola Farm, Plat Book 41, Page 51, ROHC. Tax Map 127N-A-001 through 008 as shown on the attached map.

Abandonment of unnamed alley.

Abandonment of an unnamed alley beginning on the North line of the 2000 block of Cushman Street and extending some 430 feet southwest to a dead end. Said alley separates lots 1 through 8 from lots 9 through 16, Block 2, Andersons Addition, Plat Book 3, Page 4, R.O.H.C. Tax Map 127N-A-001 through 008 as shown on the attached map.

AND WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on this petition on December 9, 2002,

AND WHEREAS, the Planning Commission heard and considered all statements favoring the petition,

AND WHEREAS, no one was present in opposition to the petition,

AND WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has studied the existing pattern of development.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Planning Commission, on December 9, 2002, recommended to the Members of the City Council of the City of Chattanooga that this petition be approved, subject to the approval of the City Engineer and all public utilities.



